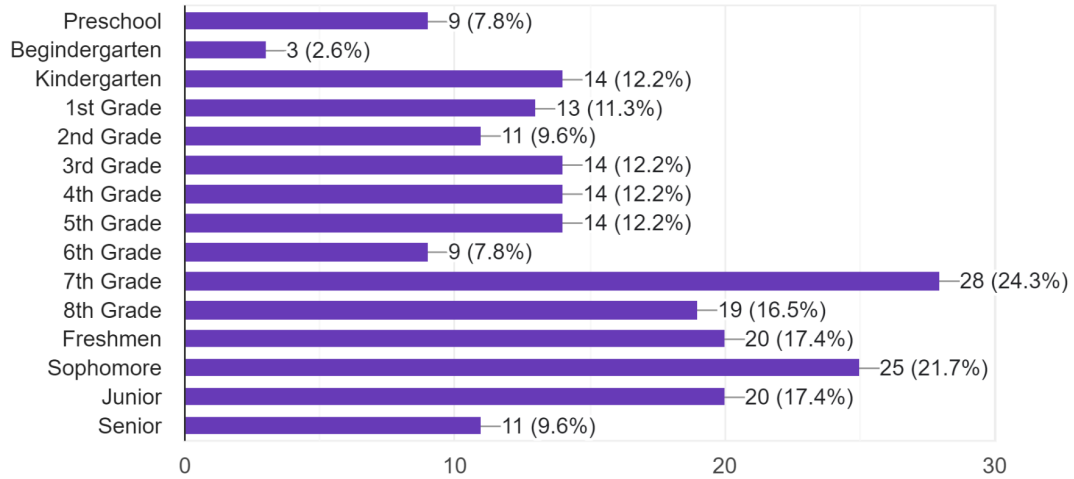


## Parent Response Summary

115 total parent responses, parent letters were sent to 147 households

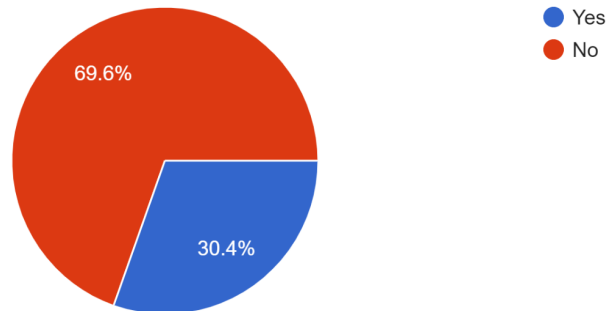
In which grade is your child(ren)? Please check all the boxes that apply.

Does your child ride the bus to and from school most days?

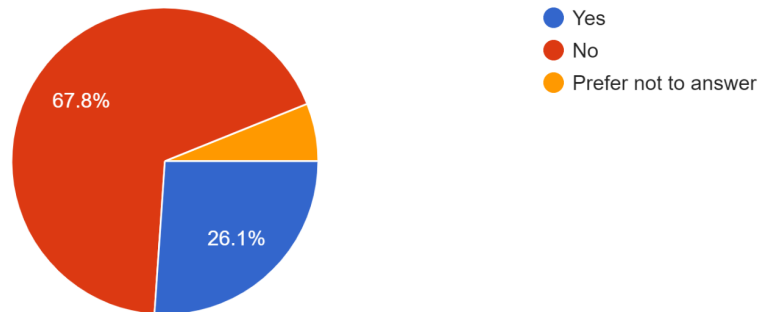
115 responses

Does your family qualify for free or reduced meals?

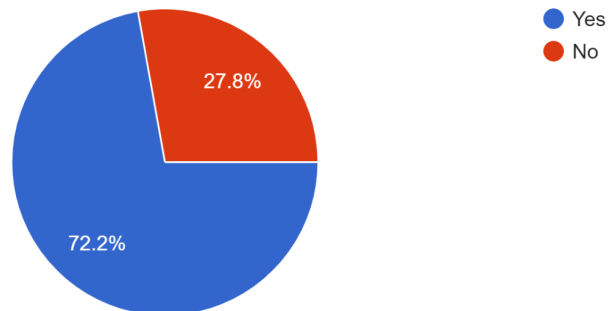
115 responses

Does your child participate on a school athletic team or other school sponsored activity that regularly meets outside of the school day?

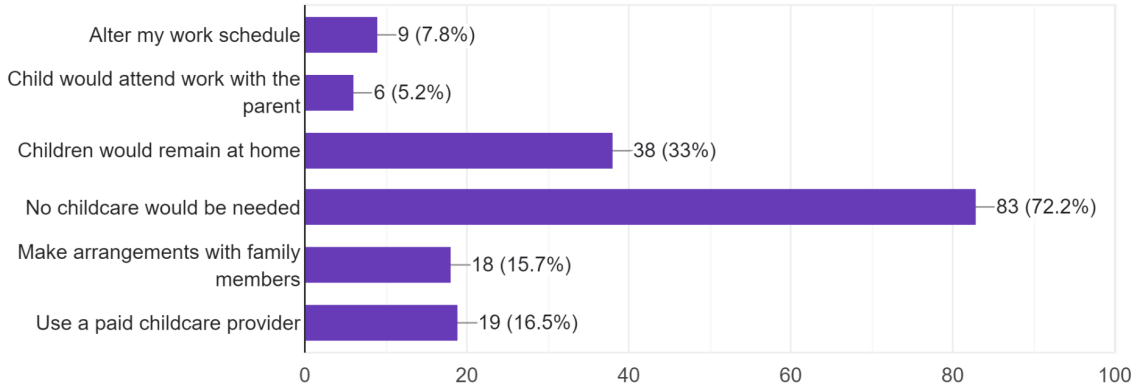

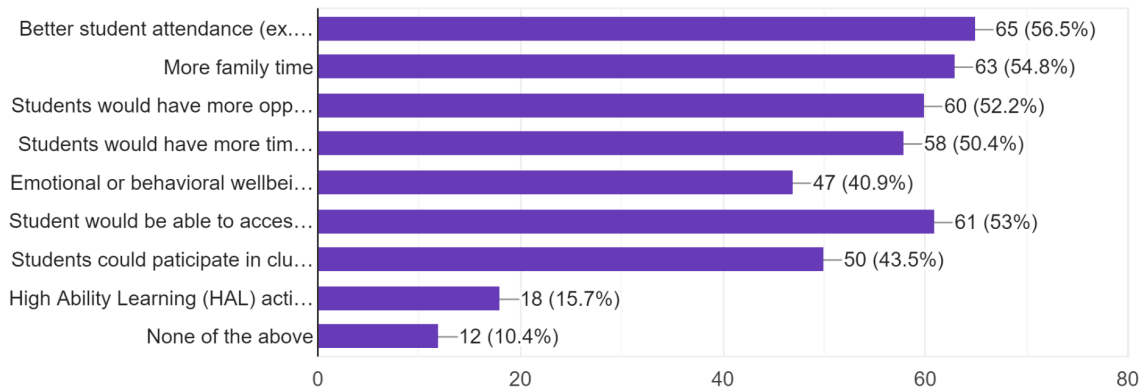
If the 4-day school week is adopted, what childcare method(s) would you most likely utilize? (Check all that apply)

Would moving to a 4-day week positively impact your family in any of the following ways (please check all that apply)

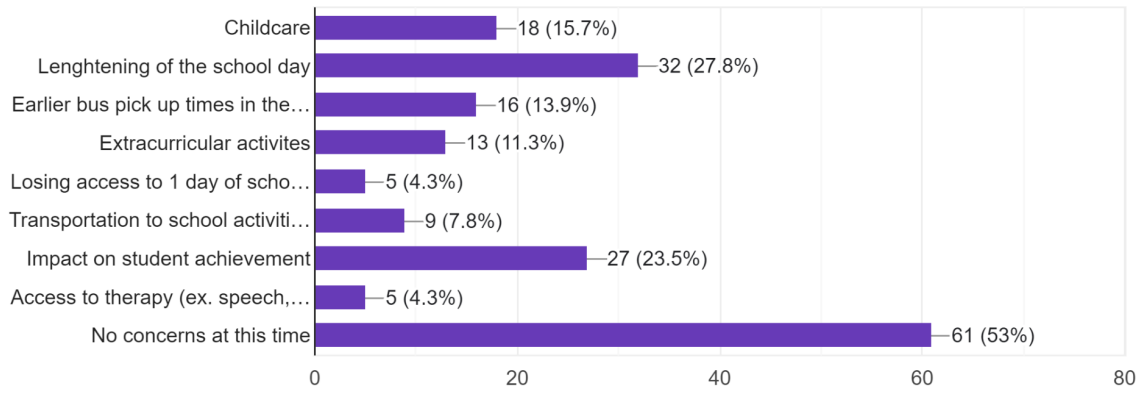
